2009-2010 GED Testing Program**

General Provisions

All regular testing sessions will be held at the Uintah School District Office on Friday evenings and the subsequent Saturday mornings. Testing will begin at 6:00 p.m. on Friday, lasting until approximately 9:45. On Saturdays, testing will begin at 8:00 a.m. and continue until 12:00 (or until testing is completed). Arrival about ten minutes early for sessions is helpful. A form of picture ID (such as current driver's license) is required in order to be admitted for testing. All needed materials for testing are provided.

Testing sessions will be limited to fifteen examinees, so applicants are encouraged to complete forms and make payments in advance in order to insure participation. The fee for the entire test is \$66.00, with retakes available for \$12.00/subtest with the exception of the Writing test which will be \$18.00. Special Accommodations

Special accommodations may be arranged for individuals with disabilities. Interested applicants are required to complete forms documenting a disability. These forms are then submitted to a state committee for possible approval. Extended time on tests, use of a scribe, and private testing sessions are examples of some possible accommodations.

Subject Areas Tested

The GED consists of five subtests. Language Arts Writing, Language Arts Reading, Social Studies, Science, and Mathematics are each tested.
