

Uintah School District School Board Highlights

February 16, 2010 business meeting

Superintendent's Report:

- a. i-Observe: The district is investigating a program to help give better feedback to teachers on their evaluation and performance. The i-Observe is a program that allows administrators to give systematic feedback to teachers about their teaching. It collects, manages and reports longitudinal data from classroom walkthroughs and teacher observation.
- b. Legislative Update: Superintendent Dockins reviewed the appropriation summaries and budget highlights of the Utah Legislative Public Education session as of March 11, 2010.
- c. YPP Data: A review of this month's YPP was presented. It is expected that once we get through this year, there will be comparative data that will help direct the district.
- d. NWEA Blended Model: Uintah School District is moving forward with NWEA Blended Model.
