006.0080 COLLEGE AND CAREER READINESS SCHOOL COUNSELING PROGRAM

REPLACES 006.0080 COMPREHENSIVE GUIDANCE PROGRAM POLICY

- 1.0 Incorporation of College and Career Readiness School Counseling Program Model.
 - 1.1 School counselors shall follow the model for College and Career Readiness School Counseling Program.
 - 1.1.1 A copy of the current College and Career Readiness School Counseling Program Model is located at:

 - 1.2 USD policy will reflect and follow the most current version of the College and Career Readiness School Counseling Model Program.
- 2.0 College and Career Readiness School Counseling Program
 - 2.1 An individual learning plan shall be implemented for each secondary school student. A secondary student’s learning plan will be referred to throughout this policy as a Plan for College and Career Readiness, or CCR Plan. A CCR Plan is developed by the student and the student’s parent or guardian, in consultation with school counselors, teachers, and administrators that:
 - 2.1.1 is initiated at the beginning of grade 7.
 - 2.1.2 identifies a student’s skill and objectives.
 - 2.1.3 maps out a strategy to guide the student’s course selection; and
 - 2.1.4 links the student to post-secondary option, including higher education and careers.
 - 2.2 Implementation of a student’s CCR Plan shall include at least the following conferences, which much be completed by a certified school counselor:
 - 2.2.1 7th and 8th grades: one individual and one group conference during the two years; (example: 7th grade group conference, 8th grade individual conference.)
 - 2.2.2 9th and 10th grades: one individual and one group conference during the two years; (example: 9th grade group conference, 10th grade individual conference.)
 - 2.2.3 11th and 12th grades: one individual and one group conference during the two years; (example: 11th grade group conference, 12th grade individual conference.) and
 - 2.2.4 Other meetings as needed.
