**PROPOSITION # 4**

If the Board of Education of Uintah County School District, Utah (the “Board”) levies the state-supported voted local levy referenced below, the Board shall reduce the capital levy so that the combined amount from the voted local levy and the capital levy will be reduced by at least \$1,000,000 from the current amount for a period of at least three years after this election (unless otherwise approved by voters).

Shall the Board be authorized to levy annually for the purpose of maintaining a state-supported voted local levy a special tax at the rate of an additional .0016 per dollar of the taxable value of the taxable property within the District, in addition to all other taxes levied or imposed on such property within the District?

A vote in favor of this tax means that the Board may increase revenue from this property tax without advertising the increase for the next five years. Notwithstanding the preceding sentence, which is required by law, this proposition restricts the ability of the Board to increase the combined capital levy and special tax levy for the specified period of at least three years.
